**Area of Assignment:** Diagnostic Imaging

**Basic Function and Scope:**

As a member of the interdisciplinary health care team the incumbent is responsible for coordinating, performing and evaluating diagnostic imaging services based on the standards of practice of Sonography Canada, College of Medical Radiation Technologists of Ontario (CMRTO), and The American Registry of Diagnostic Medical Sonography.

**Hours of Work:** Rotating shifts in the unit as required.

- Current DMS designation registered with the (CMRTO), or willingness to obtain by December 31, 2018.

Experience:

- Preference to candidates with a minimum of one year recent experience preferably in a hospital setting.

Required Skills:

- Excellent customer service skills with sensitivity to needs of multicultural clientele;
- Capable of working independently;
- Evidence of ongoing education, in accordance with Sonography Canada, CMRTO, and/or ARDMS requirement;
- Working knowledge of Hospital Information Systems and Microsoft Office;
- Ability to prioritize urgent care needs and work as a member of a team to support efficient workflow within the department and with other departments within the hospital;
- Demonstrates a commitment to a healthy and safe workplace for self and others (staff, patients and families) by taking all reasonable precautions and working in compliance with hospital related policies, health and safety legislation and completing relevant mandatory education as required;
