Basic Function and Scope:

The Charge Technologist - MRI coordinates resources, provides technical leadership in the daily operations of the MRI unit, and supports the education and development of health care providers. The Charge Technologist-MRI will conduct regular image evaluation and procedure development.

Within this role the employee is accountable for contributing to the delivery of the Lennox and Addington County General Hospital (LACGH) strategy. As an employee, one must demonstrate an awareness of and be responsible for actively promoting and supporting patient and family centered engagement and care, in all we do.

Hours of Work: Schedule rotation will include all shifts and weekends.

- Eligible for registration with College of Medical Radiation and Imaging Technologists of Ontario (CMRITO);

Experience:

- Previous hospital experience, an asset;
- Previous leadership/management experience, an asset;
- Competency on 1.5T MRI unit, computer, injection pump, patient monitor, CCTV monitoring, post-processing applications, PACS, HIS, RIS, printer/fax, telephone;
- Minimum of five (5) years recent full-time experience as an MRI Technologist, preferred.

- Excellent customer service skills with sensitivity to needs of multicultural clientele;
- Knowledge of Medical Terminology;
- Demonstrated ability with above average written and oral communication skills, and the ability to communicate effectively with a high level of professionalism in interpersonal relations;
